1. Introduction

We are Stoic and we hold a licence from the Autoriteit Financiële Markten ('AFM') as an investment firm to provide the investment service of individual asset management. Individual asset management means that we manage your assets. We do this on your behalf, at your expense and risk.

- digital platform: Stoic Client Portal ('Stoic Client Portal')

The Website is public and we use it, among other things, to provide information about our services. In addition, we may use our Website to inform you about general matters, such as our privacy policy, complaints procedure or remuneration policy. We use the Stoic Client Portal to provide you with personal information, such as your quarterly statement. You will also find information there about your asset management portfolio.

3. Accessibility of services

We provide our services digitally via our Website and Digital Platform. The Website and the Stoic Customer Portal are accessible because they are operable, perceivable, understandable and robust. For example, our Website and the Stoic Customer Portal are easy to use with a mouse, keyboard and screen reader. The font size and typeface can also be adjusted to ensure the text is clearly legible. This has been confirmed by a self-assessment carried out by Stoic on 30 April 2025. This assessment confirmed that the Website complies with the requirements set out in WCAG 2.1 AA and 2.2 AA.
